



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Bryn Mawr Online uses a two-semester system. A full-year course that meets every other day earns one credit. A semester-long course that meets every other day earns half a credit.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

English	4 credits; each semester all four years
World Languages & Cultures	3 credits; consecutive years of a language except in rare cases at departmental discretion
History	3 credits; must include US History
Mathematics	3 credits; must include Algebra II, Geometry, Precalculus
Science	3 credits; must include Physics, Chemistry, Biology
Arts	1/2 credit
Computer Science	1 credit
Physical Education	1 credit
Public Speaking	1/4 credit
Electives	2 1/4 credits

A standard course load for students in Grades 9 and 10 is either five or six courses per semester. Grades 11 and 12 are expected to carry five courses each semester.

Students enrolled in an AP course are required to take the corresponding AP Exam.

Credit for a course may be denied if a student misses more than 20% of the course due to unexcused absences or tardiness.

DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

To receive a Bryn Mawr Online diploma, a student must:

- Carry the expected course load each semester
- Maintain a satisfactory grade point average
- Earn at least 21 credits
- Complete 50 hours of community service
- Satisfy all other school requirements
- Deliver a senior speech to the community
- Successfully complete a culminating senior experience
